Hummingbird Software for the SCN

Instructions for Creating Castor, Pollux and IBM Shortcuts

1. Insert the Hummingbird CD and run the installer. Reboot your computer. Once the computer has been rebooted you will see two additional icons on your desktop: *Hummingbird Connectivity* and *Hummingbird Neighborhood*.
2. Double click on *Hummingbird Neighborhood*.
3. To Create an IBM Application Shortcut:
 - a. Locate the Default 3270 icon. Double click it to open a terminal window with the message "*The terminal is not connected*". In the Host Explorer dialog box in the center of the screen click in the *Specify a host to connect to box*. Type (all lower case: *ibm.sdp*). Uncheck the box that says *Show this dialog next time*. Click OK. You should see the SCN IBM login screen.
 - b. To create a short cut for this application on the desktop, go to the File menu and select *Save Session Profile*. In the dialog box that opens, name the profile IBM and click the Save button. Close the session window by clicking on the red X in the upper right hand corner and then Yes in the dialog box.
 - c. In the Hummingbird Neighborhood window you should now see an IBM icon that looks the same as the Default 3270 icon. Drag the IBM icon to the desktop to create a shortcut.
4. To Create a Castor Application Shortcut:
 - a. Locate the Default VT icon in the Hummingbird Neighborhood window. Double click it to open a terminal window with the message "*The terminal is not connected*". In the Host Explorer dialog box in the center of the screen click in the *Specify a host to connect to box*. Type (all lower case: *castor.sdp*). Uncheck the box that says *Show this dialog next time*. Click OK. You should see the SCN Castor login screen
 - b. To create a short cut for this application on the desktop, go to the File menu and select *Save Session Profile*. In the dialog box that opens, name the profile Castor and click the Save button. Close the session window by clicking on the red X in the upper right hand corner and then Yes in the dialog box.
 - c. In the Hummingbird Neighborhood window you should now see a VT icon named Castor. Drag the Castor icon to the desktop to create a shortcut.
5. To Create a Pollux Application Shortcut, repeat step 4 above, typing *pollux.sdp* in the *Specify a host to connect to box* and saving the session profile as Pollux.
